

Report: Caspian LPG 2010

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Caspian countries and Russia exported over 3.5 million tons of LPG to European and Asian markets in 2008 and their export will continue to grow in foreseeable future. Kazakhstan is the key regional LPG producer and exporter. The republic's production expanded to 171 thousand tons a month in October 2009 – a 26% growth to the same month a year ago. The report also analyses Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan and Azerbaijan LPG balances and production facilities.
